

# PRACTICAL INFORMATION

**Season:** from 1st of June to 15th of September

**Duration:** 7 hours (2 hours in the water paddling)

**Time of departure:** 09:00

**Meeting point:** PGI Greenland office in Ilulissat (Kussangajaannguaq 8), 15 minutes before the start of the activity.

**Minimum clients per tour:** 2

**Maximum clients per tour:** 10

**Level of difficulty:** 2/5 (moderate)

**Minimum age:** There's no minimum age, but children should be at least 1,50m tall and always be accompanied by one adult.

**Maximum age:** There's no maximum age, but elder people should be physically active in their everyday life and not have serious medical conditions.

**Price per person:** 395€ / 2.950 kr.

Includes: Boat transfer from Ilulissat to Oqaatsut and back, traditional lunch from a local home, kayaking gear for Arctic conditions (double sea kayak, paddle, thermal suit, dry suit, life-jacket, boots and gloves), English speaking guide and a USB with the pictures of the tour taken by our guide.

The duration of our activities includes the time to gear-up / dress-up, safety briefings and transfers to departure points. The time spent in the water paddling is 1 hour and 30 minutes.

## WHAT TO BRING

- First upper layer (thermal shirt, wool or synthetic)
- First lower layer ((thermal pants, wool or synthetic)
- Thick socks (wool is ideal)
- Sunglasses and sun protection
- Warm hat or peaked hat
- Prescription medication and other personal health items.
